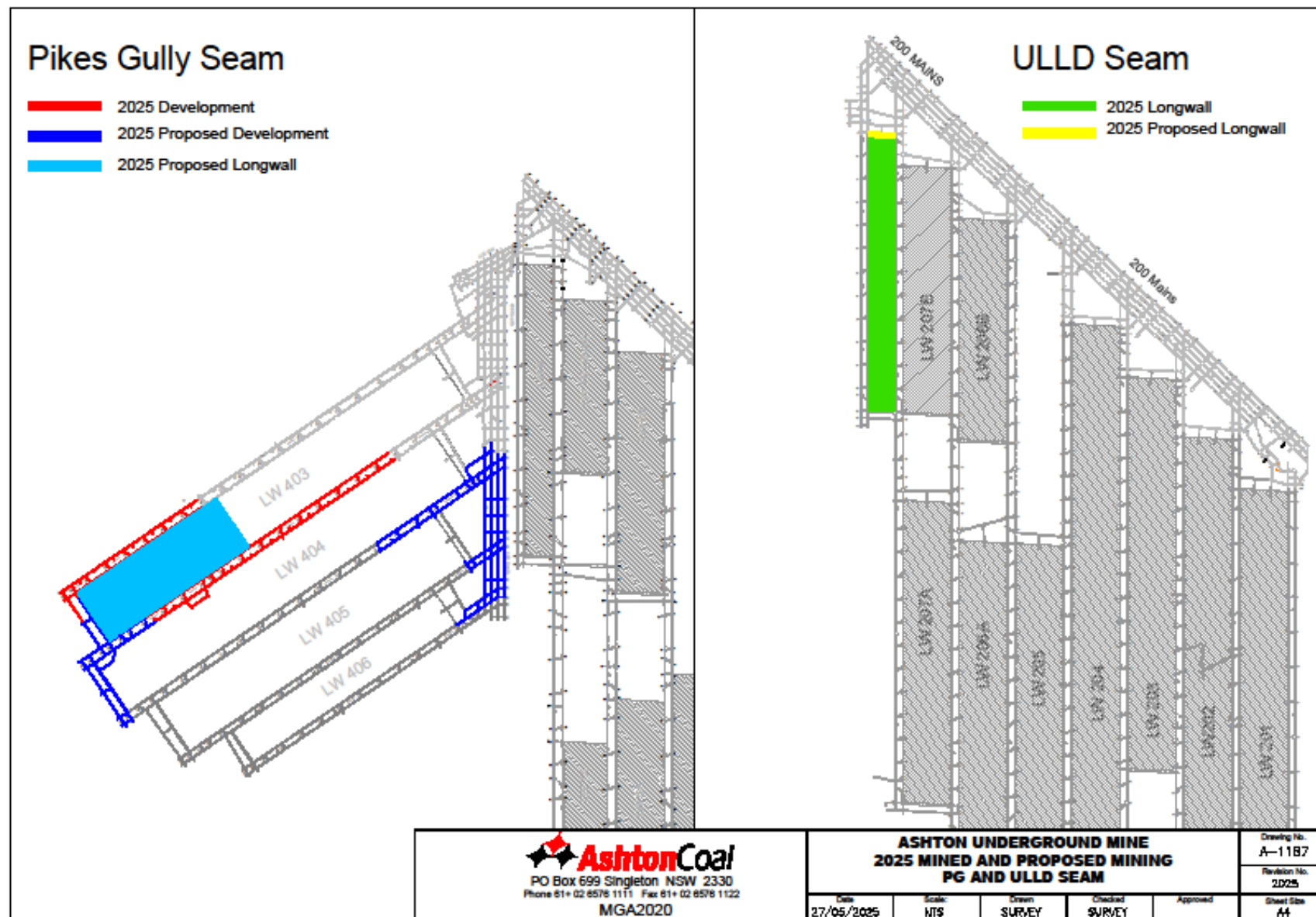

# Environmental Update

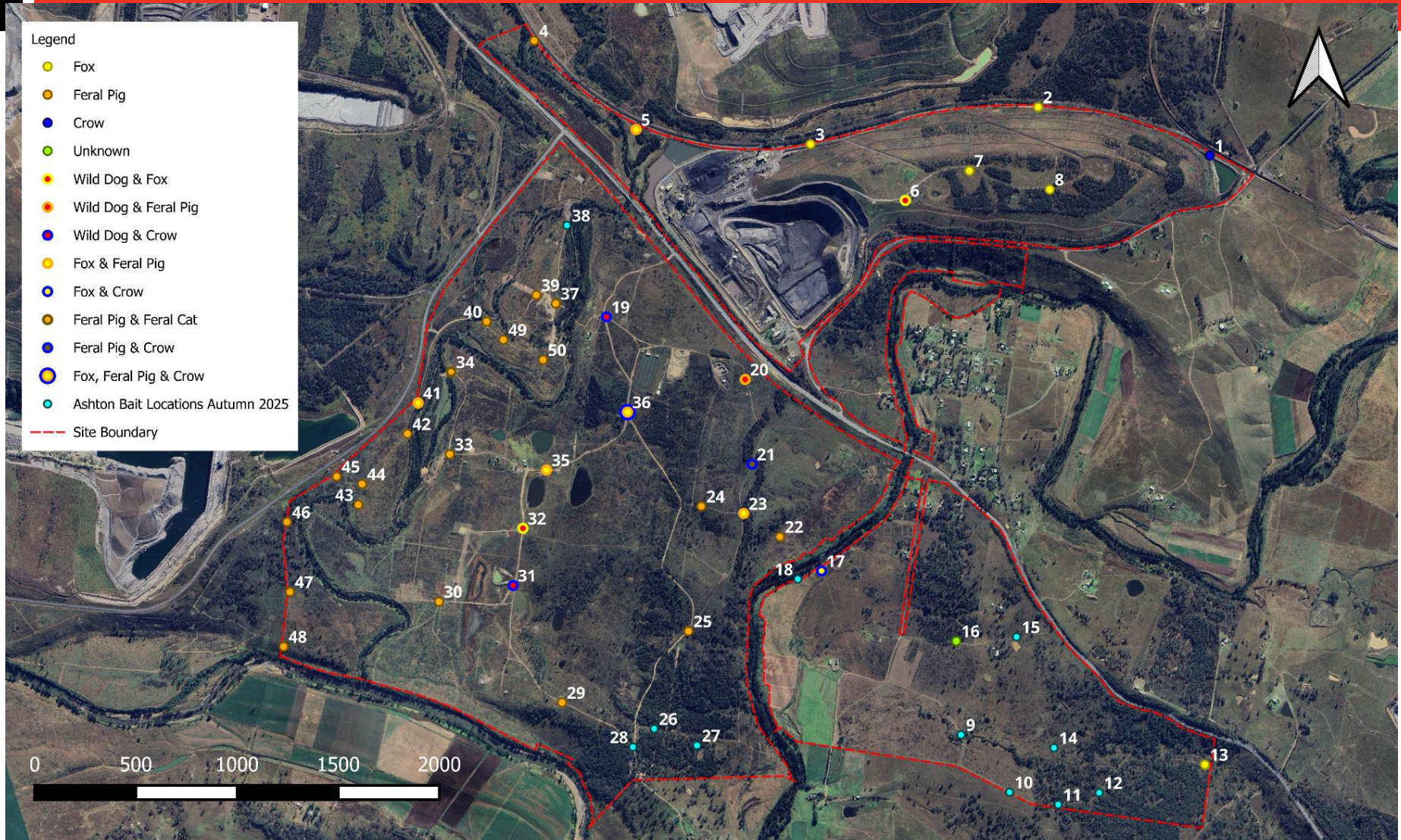
- Monthly groundwater monitoring undertaken.

- Ashton's EPA licence amended re Tailings area and production limits



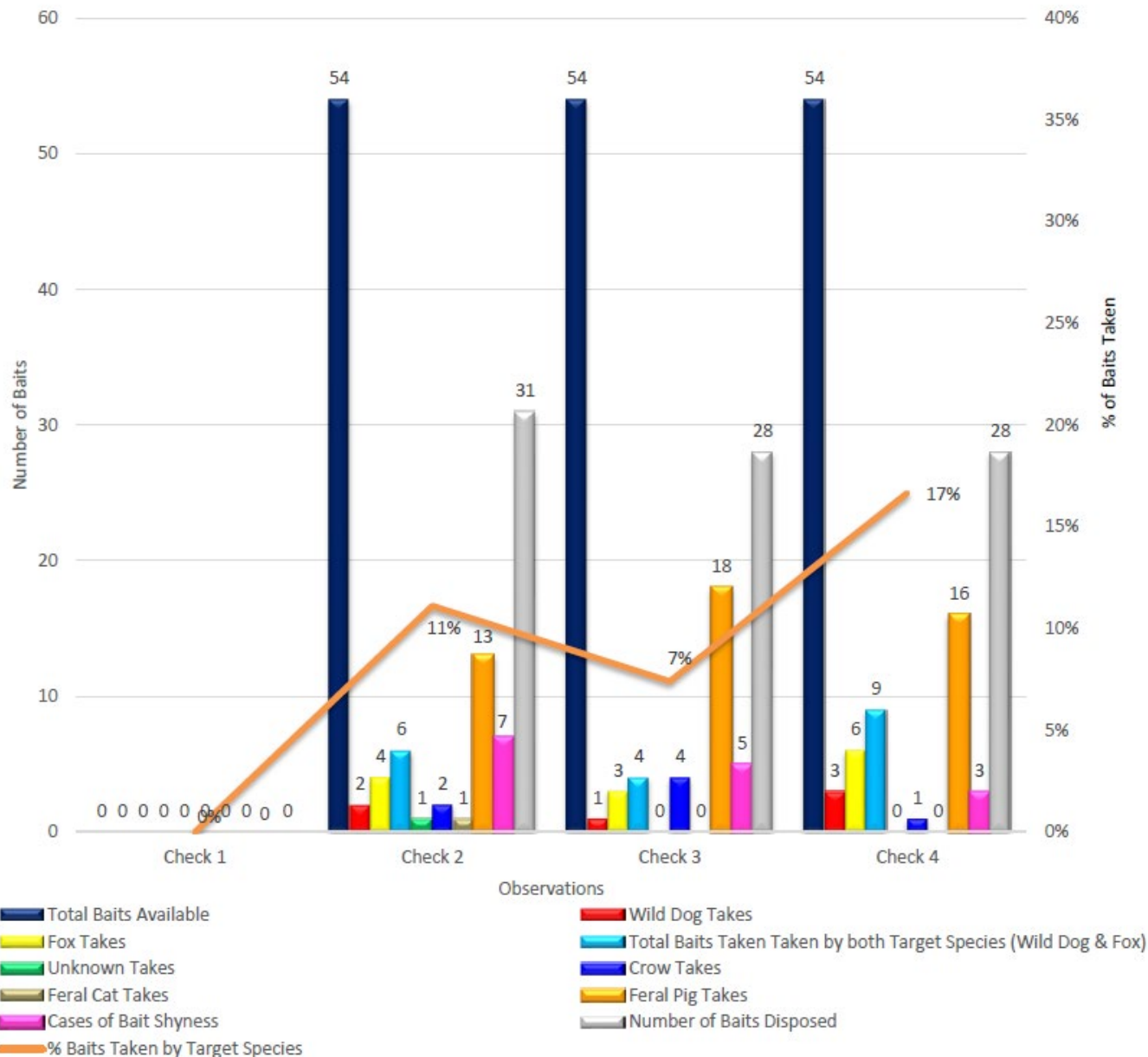

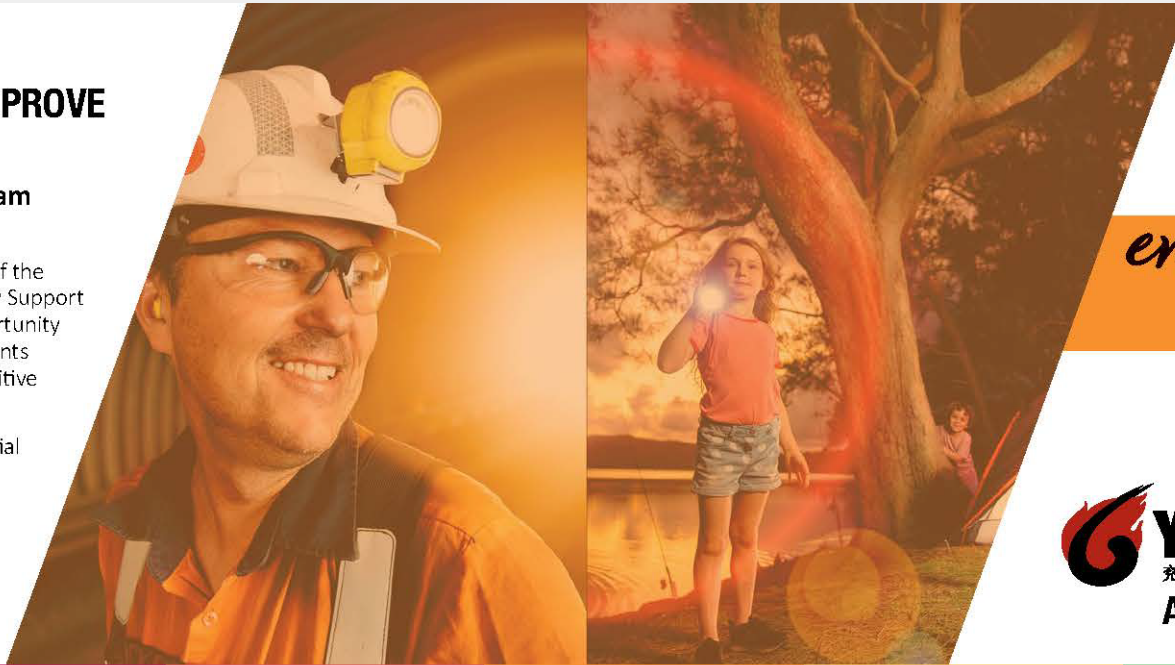
