In 2025, Yancoal's Newcastle office supported nine local community organisations aiming to make a positive difference to the Newcastle region.

Funding was shared across a diverse range of groups to enhance and run various programs including:

- Emma's Warriors – provided 40 sibling packs and 12 family meal vouchers;
- John Hunter Children's Hospital – purchased 10 breast pumps for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit;
- Charlies Run 4 Kids – supported families battling childhood cancer;
- Got Your Back Sister – assisted this domestic and family violence charity;
- Maitland Family Support Service – helped with the Christmas Hamper project;
- Maryland Fletcher Football Club ran the ' Kick Like a Girl' project;
- Soul Hub – supplied hot drinks for one month for the community;
- Morpeth 302 Fire Station – purchased the lollies for the annual Christmas lolly drive; and
- Carrie's Place – provided training material and a trainer for five sports clubs in the Maitland region.

The Newcastle Community Support Program is funded by Yancoal Australia and provides financial assistance to local groups working in the areas of health, community, environment, arts, culture, education, and training.
