Since 2004, Yancoal Australia has grown through strategic acquisitions and organic expansion. We export our high-quality thermal and metallurgical coal to a range of customers across Asian markets.

We have succeeded in developing a safe, profitable and sustainable business; we have helped to build stronger and more resilient communities; we have built a workforce culture based on shared Chinese and Australian values; and we have invested well over \$10 billion into Australian assets. In 2025, Yancoal nationally contributed \$15.6 billion in value-added economic impacts (\$7.5 billion in direct and \$8.1 billion in supply chain and consumption effects), which amounted to 0.6% of Australia's estimated Gross National Product. We also continued to be a significant contributor to Australian government revenues, paying corporate tax from our profits, state government royalties and local council rates.

Yancoal looks to the future with a clear purpose – to continue to be a reliable source of resources that power and build societies around the world.
