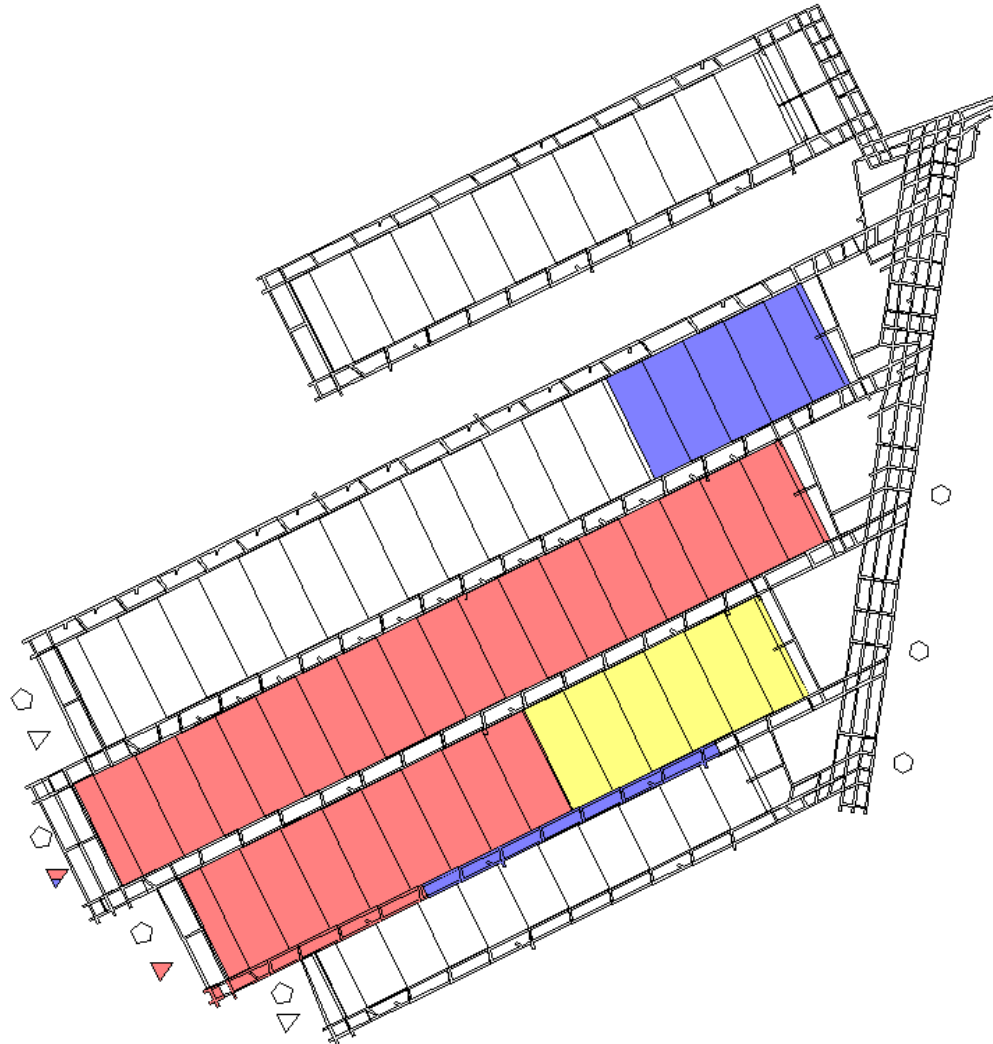

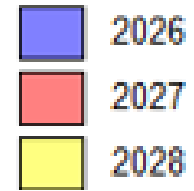

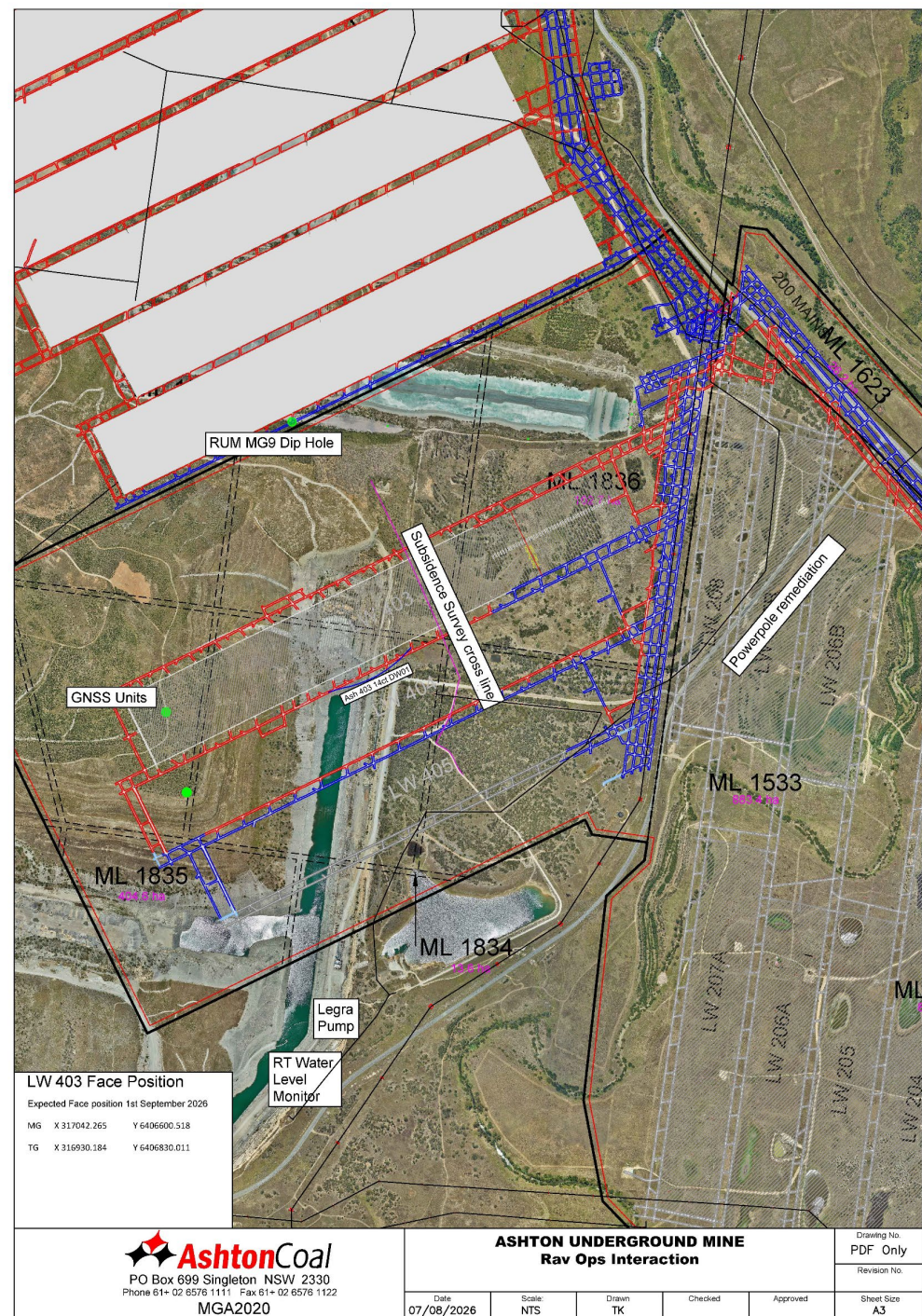

Complaints and Incidents

- Twelve complaints relating to noise from Ashton site since February and one complaint about the duration to get a response from the environmental hotline.
- One environmental incident occurred where a septic system final effluent tank overflowed. Spillage was contained on surrounding grassed area.

- Flora monitoring undertaken.
- Meeting held with Ashton RAPs for the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report for RUMEx.
- Swallow cull undertaken in store and maintenance workshop.
- Ashton's 2025 Annual Review submitted to Department of Planning.
- Ashton's Rehabilitation Management Plan, Forward Plan and updated Rehabilitation Cost Estimate submitted to Resource Regulator.
- Independent Environmental Audit report submitted to Planning.
- Ashton EPA Annual Return submitted.

Environmental Update

- Noise monitoring undertaken in Camberwell as background regarding noise issues.
- Noise monitoring was undertaken at a complainant's address in Camberwell. The conclusion was that of the 271 valid 15-minute measurements at NM2, there were no occasions where estimated mining noise from ACM was above the relevant limits. The complainant has been made aware of the results.
- Controlled burnoff undertaken by rural fire services.
- Fauna monitoring including spotlighting was undertaken.
- ACCF Meeting held with Ashton RAPs.
- Aquatic ecology survey undertaken on Bowman's Creek
